 - Here's a Progress Monitoring by Instructional Text Reading Level chart
 - Chart shows where students should be at their grade level
 - Here's a handout of current ELD program including supports, number of students identified and group size/schedule
 - 12 of our newcomers are below grade level; half of which have had no formal education in their home country or the U.S.
 - Students are receiving 3 hours a week of small group instruction and includes ELD, guided reading and a socio emotional component (includes activities that encourage social interaction)
 - Cannot work with middle school students because do not have enough staff support (i.e., one part time aide only)
 - Seeing 14 ELD groups and 5 newcomer groups
 - Notice number of students are in need of reading intervention; there are many also needing intervention but we do not have coverage for them
 - Can accomplish more if we had more staff
 - Suggestions:
 - Teachers can observe facilitation of Literacy Footprints (guided reading) to acquire strategies to use in their classroom
 - Next steps:
 - Need running records for 7/8 to determine reading levels
 - Need additional staff support (i.e., one staff in the morning and one staff in the afternoon)
 - Maslah: Will consider and try to accommodate request
 - Would like more up to date training based on the latest research that supports
 ELD (aside from GLAD that applies more to the general classroom)
 - Abdi: We will accommodate this request
 - Need a few supplies
