- Standards for Local Performance Indicator, Quick Guide
 - Annual summary to determine if school is performing based on performance standards
 - Score: 4/5 for Priority 1: Appropriately aligned teachers, access to curriculum-aligned instructional materials, and safe, clean and functional facilities
 - Score 3-4/5 for Priority 2: Implementation of State Academic Standards - have standards-aligned curriculum for most subjects
 - Score 5/5 Priority 3: Family Engagement
 - Score 4/5 Priority 6: School Climate - Local climate survey to go out upcoming school year (CA Healthy Kids Survey)
 - Significant improvement in student safety during lunch and recess after implementing "Iftin's Friendly Playground" (eg., spread out and organized play areas; staggered recess w/ less students out playing)
 - Fadumo Nur: Students fighting after school; Parents complaining that from 440-5p students fighting with no supervision present
 - Austin-Singer: Is there supervision on blacktop?
 - Abdi: Yes, and no balls allowed and BeUtmost and supervision aides present after school
 - Fadumo Nur: Would like armed security
 - Abdi: Will have all stakeholders' input on having an armed guard at the front gate
- Summer School June 26- July 27 - 18 days
 - Will align with ELOP
 - Focus on reading, writing, word study, spelling and math
 - Will stay true to 1:10 ratio and have small classes
 - 1 hour PE
 - Franco/Austin-Singer: Red zone students should be priority to make more effective
 - Priority to low-performing students but open to all
 - Austin-Singer: Suggest to group students by academic level versus by grade to make program more productive
 - Abdi: Will use data tracker to make determinations; need to know first how many students are participating before grouping students
 - Dr Sciurba will be leading summer school
