<div>Start: 930a</div> <div>Decisions made/Kudos/Questions/Concerns:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Ismail: Have been collecting data on different students who have had behavioral challenges;<ul style="list-style-type: none">Will meet with students 1:1, small groups and in character ed class to make impact and implement counseling program fully next school yearFranco: Does data get entered into PowerSchool?Ismail: No, because it's confidential but have data and can discuss with appropriate parties; students will have a file and a plan with goal that they are working toward; need to educate parents as well about social emotional health; will use standards from CA Health EducationFranco: Are you overseeing character ed?Ismail: Use blocks w/ Mr Dean but program will work separately; however, do need a whole class session and a classroomHori: I appreciate the healthy environment that teachers provide for their students; we also want to make sure every child is successfulFranco: Do you think character ed is working in the way that it should?Austin-Singer: PBIS hasn't been necessarily been implemented fully or hasn't had follow through; should have a program that is truly school-wide and implemented at the beginning of the school year vs mid-year; need to get off ground on day 1Allison: PBIS is a program and a system that needs to be implementFranco: Maybe creating a committee and making PBIS our yearly focus ; build it slowly until fully implemented; all staff is empowered;Abdi: County has combined PBIS and restorative practice called MTSS; it's a team approach; we applied for a 2 year MTSS grant; training will be providedMaslah: Plan to have all teachers certified with MTSS and our school will be PBIS certifiedAllison: Perhaps we should focus on one or two things next year that way we can really make sure our plans come to fruitionHussein: Some students do not know why they're learning and may easily give up; students need to know why they're in school;Abdi: Will provide pre-recorded webinar of MTSS; all system-basedAdmin team w/ specialists will provide more guidance with next year's programs; along with feedback from teachers
