FY24-25 School Transportation Needs for Students

Challenges:

- Newcomer families often lack the resources and support systems to navigate the complexities of the U.S. school system. They might not be aware of available transportation options, have difficulties accessing them, or face financial barriers.
- Organizing transportation for field trips can be challenging
- Ensuring all students, including those with disabilities and those from immigrant families, can participate in field trips without transportation barriers.
- Public transportation long commute times can be tiring and reduce study time.
- Increased risk of absenteeism due to transportation issues.
- Safety concerns during adverse weather conditions.

Needs:

- Reliable and punctual bus service with established pick-up and drop-off points.
- Flexible and reliable transportation options that can accommodate varying group sizes and diverse destinations.
- Comfortable seating and climate control on buses to ensure a pleasant journey.
- Availability of after-school transportation for extracurricular activities.
- Emergency contact system for parents to track bus status.

Solution:

The school will purchase two 15-seater vans to provide flexible and efficient transportation for students living further away. These vans will offer more personalized routes and quicker travel times compared to larger buses, providing a more versatile and efficient transportation option for school excursions.

General Recommendations

- **Safety Protocols:** Implement stringent safety protocols including regular driver training, emergency drills, and safety equipment on buses.
- **Communication:** Establish a robust communication system to keep parents informed about schedules, delays, and any emergencies.
- **Technology Integration:** Use GPS tracking and mobile apps to allow parents and school administrators to monitor bus locations in real-time.
- Feedback Mechanism: Create a feedback system for parents and students to report issues and suggest improvements in the transportation service.
